Trust in the Lord

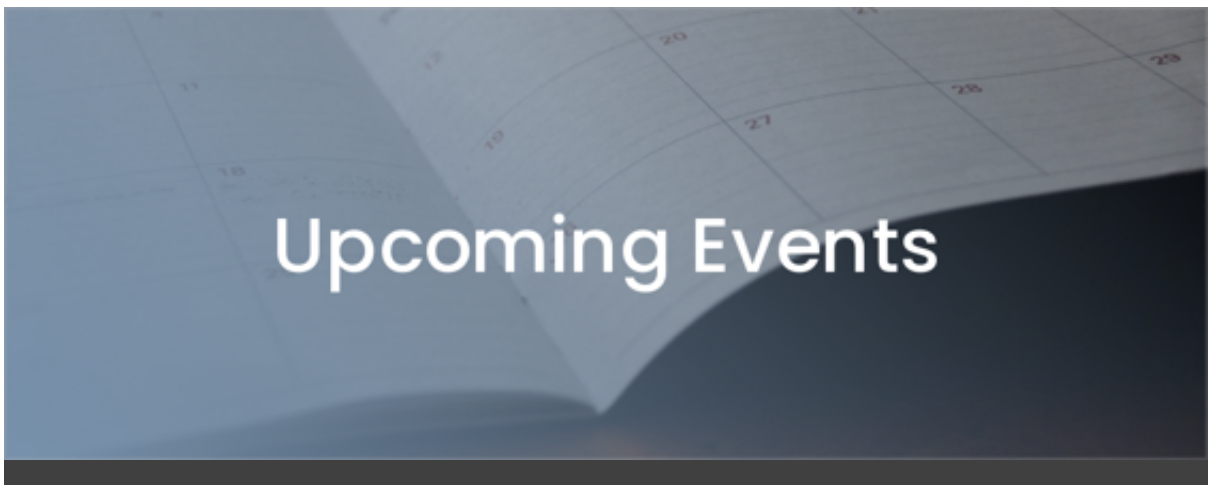
It has been over a month now since the passing of my mother. I miss her terribly, and my morning devotional for today just brought back more memories of her.
